Valid identification

INN University accepts a copy of the following types of identification:

- Norwegian passport (not emergency passport)
- Norwegian bank card with photo
- Norwegian driver's license issued after 1 January 1998
- Military ID card
- Norwegian Maritime Book
- Posten's ID card
- Norwegian travel document for refugees
- Immigration passport (not approved if it is issued for a single trip)
- Foreign passport (not emergency passport)
- ID card from EU / EEA country

All Norwegian identification must have both a photo and an ID number / D-number (11 digits). The identification will not be accepted if the ID number / D-number is illegible or only partially displayed.
