



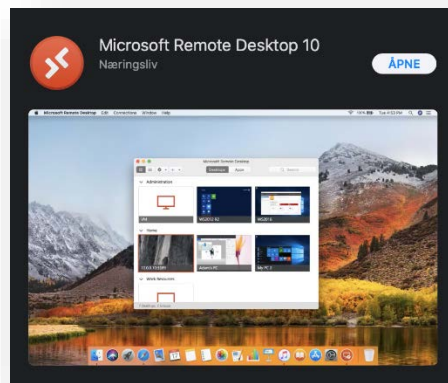
## How to use SPSS/StataSE from a web-browser.

### Dependencies:

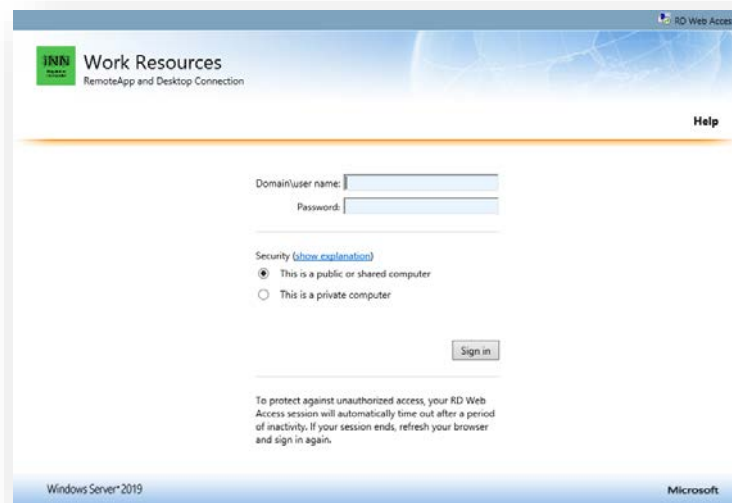
- Your computer must be connected to a network with Internet Access.
- You must be registered as a student in a program where this software is used.

### Startguide

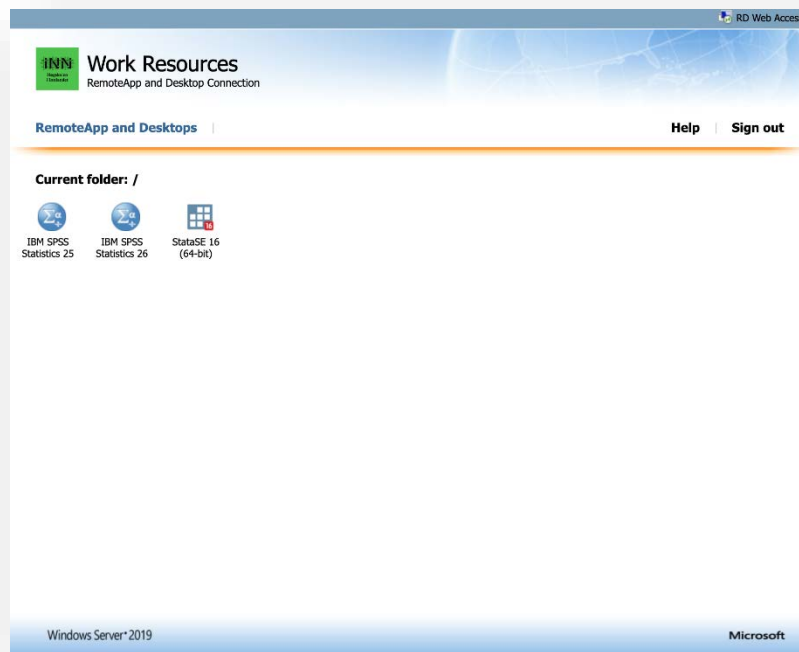
1. Start App Store and download&install the latest version of Microsoft Remote Desktop 10:



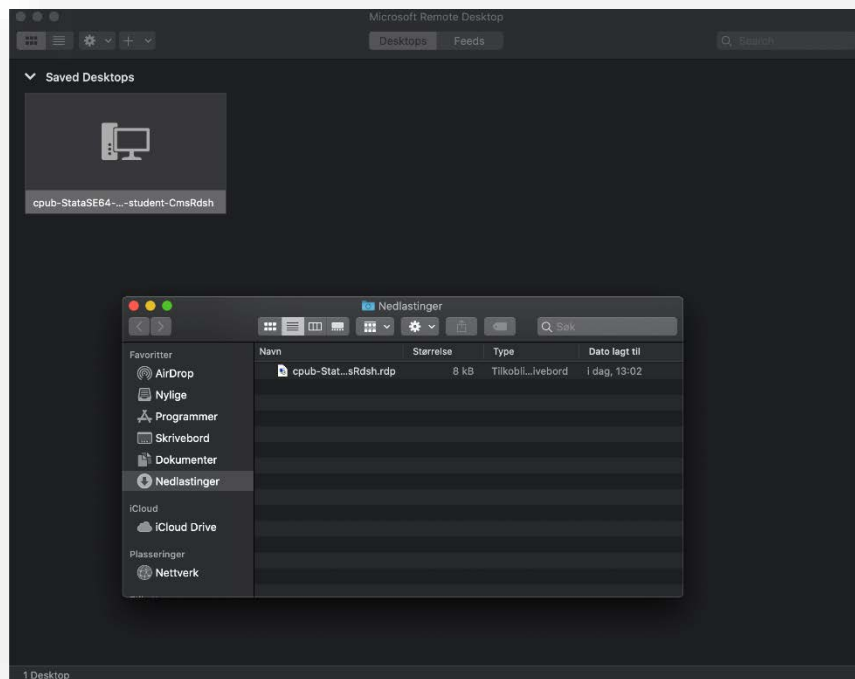
2. Start your web browser and enter the site <https://remoteapp.inn.no>. You will now see a login portal. Use your student number and password to login. You have to use «inn\» before your username/student number: inn\username



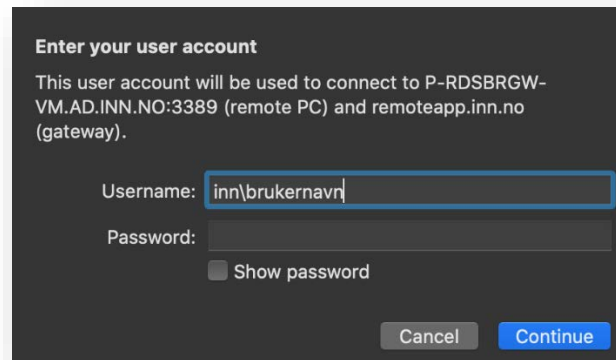
- You will now get an overview of available software: IBM SPSS Statistics 26/StataSE. Start the software by pressing the icon and an rdp-file will be downloaded.



- To use and start the software with the downloaded rdp-file, please start Microsoft Remote Desktop software. Then, drag and drop the rdp-file in the Microsoft Remote Desktop Window.

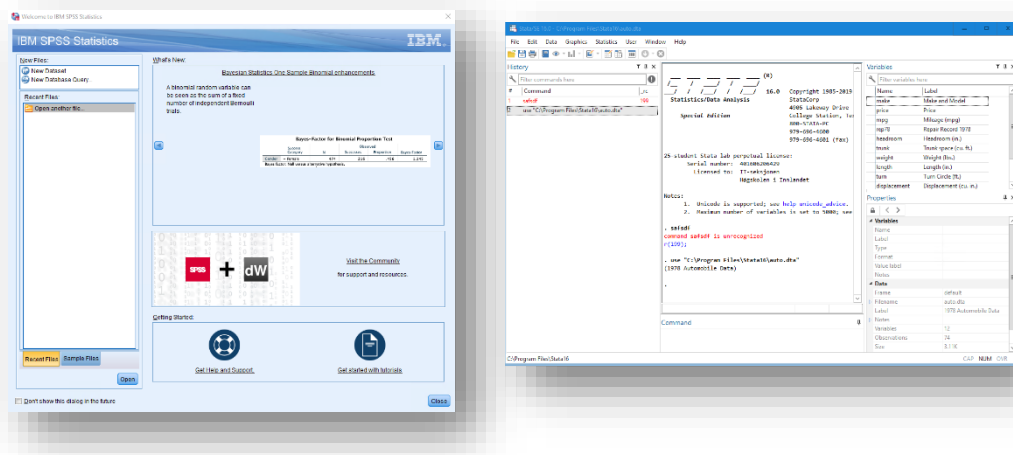


- You will now be asked to enter your username and password one more time. Remember to use «inn\» in front of your username/student number.

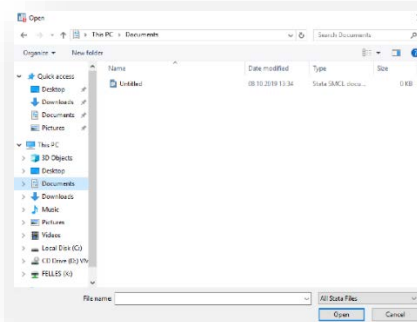


Next you need to verify your identity with two-step verification against Microsoft 365. We recommend using your Microsoft Authenticator app for two-step verification. Two-step verification with SMS will not work in this scenario.

- It will take some time to start up SPSS the first time. StataSE will be faster to launch.



- When you save files they will be stored in your local profile on the server. No-one else have access to this folder.
